Three generations in my family have loyally worked at Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard. My maternal grandfather was a shipwright, my father was a radio operator, and I worked there as a military housing carpenter.

P.S.: My situation is one where I do not have a savings or royal treasury. And for the last 36 years, I had a bad back due to working as a carpenter and therefore I am not employable. Within the past year, my legs gave way (knees) and I was diagnosed as having torn ligaments, bone spurs and fractures. The MRI finding was that I had torn meniscus on both knees (as well as other forms of damage), which prevented me from walking and therefore I am not employable in my field of trade as a carpenter. Since then I have gone back to college and finished my four years, but did not do my last few required courses; which is Statistics II, two years of a foreign language, and Business Policy. I am under doctors care and walking with the aid of leg braces (on both legs) and crutches. I hope to go back to school and finish my degree after 20 or 30 years of being away from college.

I am, also, in need of optical and dental care, which may cost over \$6,000. Money which I do not have and money that my State of Hawaii insurance (HMSA) will not fully cover. HMSA has, also, dropped me as a client and they didn't say why. Perhaps, they consider a government negotiator too high a risk, yet other American negotiators are covered by their medical insurance plans. I have no idea why I was dropped by HMSA. Please look into this, too, for me, as I do need medical insurance.

I, also, hope to return to my consulting and international negotiation practice as a political liaison and negotiator.
