A private and confidential letter to and for all immediate family members, to and for all of the descendants of our grandfather's three younger brothers (all of the Chow surnamed people in Hawaii), and to and for all descendants of China's Chou Dynasty in China and worldwide, as well as to and for people whose ancestors migrated to Hawaii and America along with us, who make up and were a part of China's royal family and Chou Dynasty history.

I have a back injury sustained from my work as a carpenter (mid- and lower-back) 36 years ago and torn meniscus in both knees as well as other types of damages to both knees. I am in need of dental work and new glasses. My asthma may return, but I am hoping that my health will hold up and this should not be that great of a concern. My vision is poor and my body feels a bit tired. Dental work may cost me, I estimate, between \$3,000 to \$6,000.

Additionally, in the mornings I am having problems just getting out of bed as my legs don't seem to work so well\* and are not that strong. I may, I hope not, perhaps, not that soon, need a motorized wheelchair to get around. My landlord has a spare wheelchair left to her from a previous tenant.

Please get back to me ASAP. Hoping to hear from you!

\*Notation: I am a weak swimmer, yet I am able to swim the length of an ordinary swimming pool. With my knee injury, I am not able to swim at all. I tried swimming at Ala Moana Beach and I could not swim a stroke. I sank in the water at the beach that day. My knee injury may be getting progressively worst with each passing day and I am a bit scared as I do not want to be an invalid. There is much that I want to do, even at the age of 62. I am wishing for the best and trying to take good care of myself. I hope that the entire family and clan will look into this and will get back to me. I, also, have trouble getting up and out of chairs. I am not able to walk on hard surfaces, generally speaking, without limping, due to the pain. There is great pain and much difficulty in getting up out of a chair or bed. My knee pains occur on a daily basis.

I was told that some of you have the same problem problems. I would hate to believe that our physical problems are genetic. I am a Christian and a man of faith. No problem could be so great that it is too great for God. I admit that man is imperfect. We have flaws and failings, even many generations before us, flaws only to be covered up by many in the past. I hope that I might be able to get the clan together, the descendants of grandfather and the descendants of his three younger brothers. I hope that you might be able to notify and get our immediate family together to pay a visit to me. By the words "immediate family", as I use it here, I am referring to the descendants of our grandfather and the descendants of his three younger brothers. We make up the nucleolus of China's imperial family. Those who choose not to participate lose their family mandate. It is in their interest as well as the entire clan's interest for them (as China's imperial princes) to meet with me in such a crucial period of my life.
