Dear Brother Martial Arts Clubs and Practitioners,

Some of you know me, I believe, from earlier letters. Some don't. Unfortunately, when I first wrote my words were jumbled and my letters did not make any sense. I very humbly and with great embarrassment profusely apologize. Sometimes, people live disorganized lives, due to whatever reasons, and our words do not at first come out well as it

should. If a person is an international celebrity, a man who is supposed to carry a lot of esteem, he must live up to expectations or people will poo-poo him and his good name.

I am writing to all of you because your style of martial arts comes from a branch of my family and there is a bit of honor and a relationship here which I would like to foster and cement. My uncle (second-uncle) is William Kwai Sun Chow (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/William_Kwai_Sun_Chow), also known as Professor Chow of the Chinese Kempo fame in Hawaii. Grandmaster Samuel Kuoha (<http://www.karaho.com>), now, inherits Professor Chow's style and name, though not exclusively. The real truth about my second-uncle, Great Grand Master William Kwai Sun Chow (Professor Chow), has never been told. Those of you, who have been in Hawaii, I believe, do know of Professor Chow. His Chinese Kempo is second to none and should never be belittled. I am pure Chinese and by the history of China officially emperor of China. My family comes from the north and settled in Chungshan, China. There Chinese migrated to Hawaii and the style of Kungfu practiced in Hawaii, which my extended clansmen in Hawaii do, is done by a Chinese club called the Chinese Physical Culture Association. The purpose of this club is the cultural preservation of our Chinese culture and not the practice of Kungfu as a fighting art.

If any fighting art represents the Chow clan, family, and name, in my best judgment, it is Jow Ga. Yet, the people from my family Albert Chow and William K.S. Chow, both, practiced a form of Wing Chun and William K.S. Chow's art, due to how it came about, was called Chinese Kempo.

All Black Belt ranks go up to 10th degree, by modern custom and practice. Ed Parker (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Ed_Parker), a student of Frank Chow and William Chow, once long ago announced, to Professor Chow (his teacher), that he, Ed Parker, holds a 10th degree in martial arts. The Professor said that if Parker is a 10th degree Black Belt, then he (William Chow) is 20th degree. The Professor spoke honestly and upfront, honestly without any vain boast. The Professor was honored subsequently, I believe, after his death, from the martial arts community with a posthumous award of 15th degree Black Belt and no one to this day was given this posthumous honor. This speaks reams about the Professor.

Through the entire four thousand year history of the Chow clan in China there has always been a very close relationship between the Chow clan (family) and the Chun clan. This relationship was, also, honored and maintained by Professor Chow. So, while Samuel Kuoha inherits Professor Chow's practice, it is Bill Chun, Grandmaster William Q.C. Chun, Senior (www.chinesekempo.org), who inherits most or all of the underpinnings or practice of Professor Chow's style. The Chow clan for many centuries has always had a very close relationship with the Chun clan and so if there was anyone who Professor Chow taught it would be Bill Chun, Sr., someone, who the Professor paid special attention to. Also, privy to Professor Chow's inside style was Grandmaster Adriano Emperado (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Adriano_Directo_Emperado) and people in Adriano's family. Martial arts changes over the years and what you see in the past, as to who is good and who is the best, does change. Styles evolve and skill levels increases with time. Yet, for his day 1940s to 1970s, it is my statement and the knowledge of many martial artists, Professor Chow was the top martial artist of his day. There was no one better in the entire martial arts world and the Professor never got recognition in books or in public for his achievements and skills level.

I hold the name of William Q.C. Chun and Adriano D. Emperado, therefore, in very high esteem.

Though there have been disagreements between Grandmaster Kuoha and myself, I apologize, publicly, and confess that I hold the highest esteem for Grandmaster Kuoha for his achievements and I think highly of him and his club. It is better to forgive and to let old wounds heal, rather than to be angry at people and to hold senseless grudges.

I hope that there is a healing in the martial arts community and that those of like-faith, like-practice, like-art, related trees, can get together and share in each other's art.
