Dear Mr. Salazar,

I hope that you do receive this letter and that you will read it with great interest. Officially by China's history and by the Han-Chinese Imperial lineage, I am China's official emperor (emperor-in-exile) today. My grandfather came to this country as a 10 year old boy in 1871. My father and I were born here. My whole family loves living in America and loves being American citizens. My family hopes one day to return to China and taking our rightful place as China's imperial family. So, we wait for the best opportune moment and for a suitable relationship with your government.

We are not communist. We are not traitors or subversives to your nation. We are and have always been loyal Americans of Chinese ancestry waiting for official recognition, the love of your nation, and approval of your government for our eventual return to China.

My letter to you is in response to a recent article found in the Sunday edition (07-31-2011) of the Honolulu Star-Advertiser (<http://staradvertiser.com>) on page F-6 titled "Asian markets tempt U.S. coal producers". Basically what the article said was that you are/will be opening up U.S. lands with coal and that China and other Asian nations will or may be purchasing soon. The article went on to say that there is some opposition to the selling of U.S. assets to foreign sources like China.

Officially by China's history and by my family's 4,000 year genealogy record and succession, as found throughout China's entire history time period, I am China's emperor and head of state as opposed to a Manchurian succession rule of China. Yet, I am a loyal American and three or more generations in my family have been born here in the US.

My vision is American as I grew up here. My family having lived in your nation for over 130 years. I inherit the Imperial succession of China's and I am a Christian. As a good man and upright American, I hope to return home to China with

the love of America. I hope to help China modernize and to make stronger and better a communist nation. When you have good people doing good things in this world, no matter what their title is and ignoring ethnic bounds and titles, this world becomes better for it.

I hope to be thought of as a friend to America and I am hoping for the love of Americans for my eventual return to China. Too often people in high places play games and people are never truly sincere, honest, or open with the people they supposedly serve. I can only hope that America will treat me with dignity and that her politicians will always be honest and upright with me, whether I am an emperor seeking to return home to China or when I am back home in China installed as China's emperor and head of state.

I am writing, too, because I am in poverty; unemployed, homeless, disabled, and living out on the streets of America (Honolulu, Hawaii) with no money, no friends, and no family.

I am in need of medical care, very expensive vision and dental, food, housing, etc. And your government's Social Security and Hawaii's State welfare benefits have not been fully available to me yet (after some 36 years). I have no income, no assets, and no savings of any kind. How am I to survive in your nation?

I wrote to President Obama and to the last four U.S. Presidents. My letters to President Obama has fallen on deaf ears. When I send letters to Secretary Clinton, my e-mail and fax letters were not accepted by the Office of the Secretary of State and were deleted. So, if one needed help in this nation, how are we, foreign heads of state, going to be cared for and expected to survive?

If the head of state of another nation, whether China's emperor or Norway's king, migrated to the US to live and was without the necessities of life, how should we be treated in your nation in view of the fact that we had to flee from our family's homelands with no money and with nothing? What do we do and would the U.S. government do anything to help us?

I patiently await your kind and humble reply to this letter.
